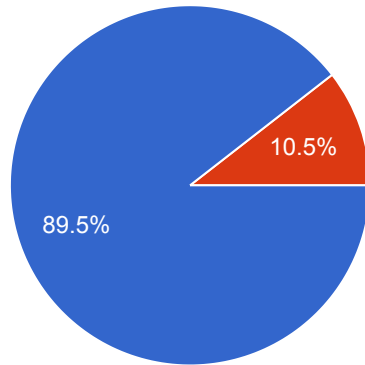

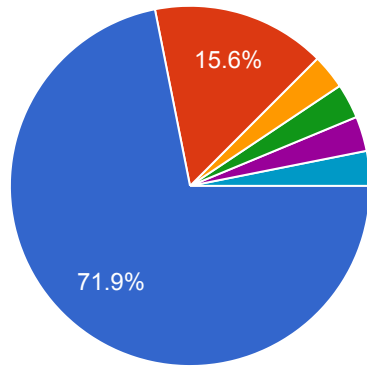

If you voted by ABSENTEE BALLOT, how did you request it?

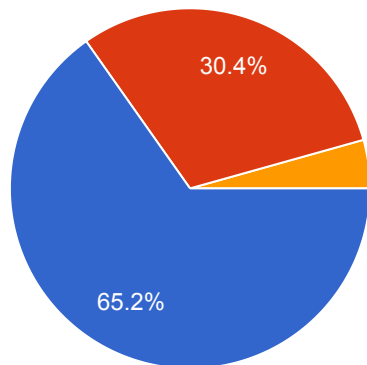

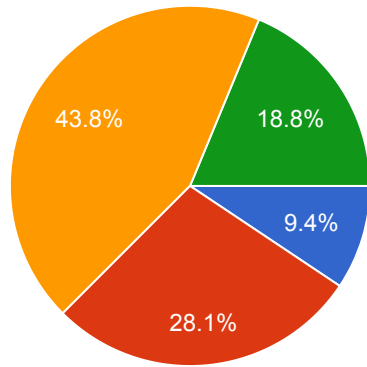

When did you request your ABSENTEE BALLOT?

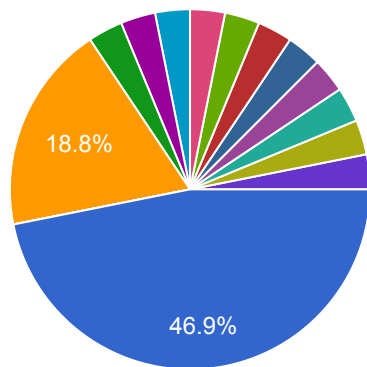

When did you receive your ABSENTEE BALLOT?

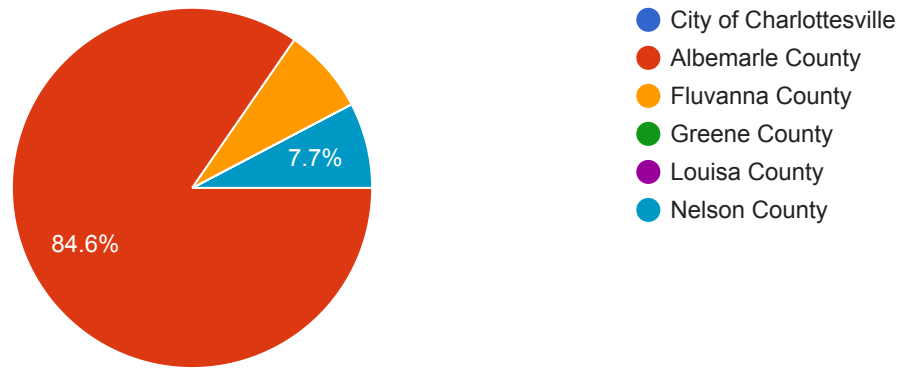

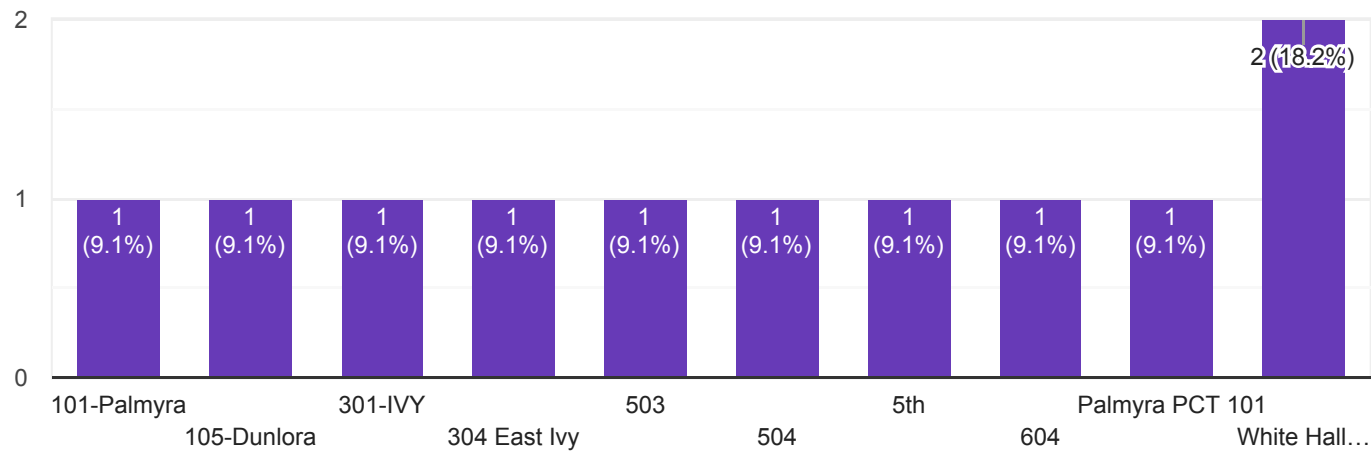
The following questions are for IN-PERSON VOTING: In what city or county did you vote?

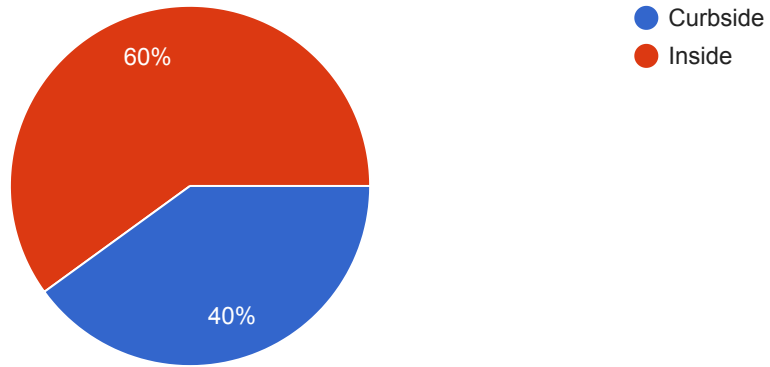
If known, what is your Precinct Number? Info can be found on your voter registration card. Not required/ would be helpful.

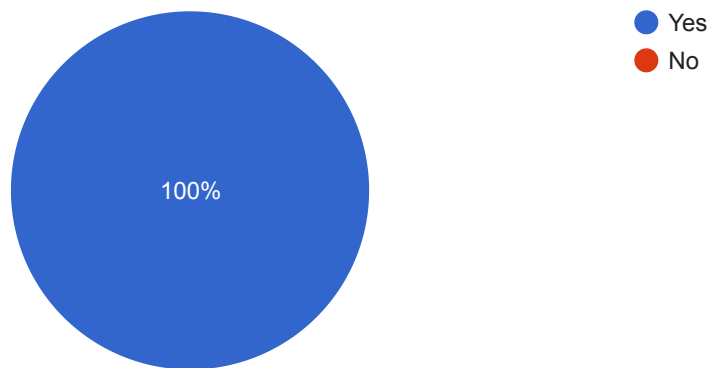
Did you vote curbside or inside IN-PERSON VOTING.
