You are eligible to register to vote if you are:

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Virginia
- At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election

#### **VOTER REGISTRATION**

Where You may apply online or at the following sites: County Registrar Office, Public Library; Department of Motor Vehicles Offices; Public Assistance Agency offices, i.e., those offering food stamps, aid to dependent children and/or aid to persons with disabilities, etc.; Military Recruitment Offices, or District Governmental Centers. For other locations and for more information contact your General Registrar.

When You may register year round except during the 21 days prior to a general or primary election or 13 days prior to a special election. Registration will be permanent under most circumstances.

#### ABSENTEE VOTING

Any registered voter may request an absentee ballot.

**By Mail or Fax**: Absentee ballot application forms are available at the voter registration office or can be downloaded from the voter registration website. A voter can opt to have ballots for future elections mailed, instead of submitting an application for each election. Complete mailed applications must be received by the General Registrar not less than 10 days before an election. Voted ballots returned via USPS must be postmarked by election day and received by the registrar by the 3<sup>rd</sup> business day after the election.

In Person: Registered voters may vote during early voting at the Registrar's office beginning 45 days before an election. In-person early voting ends at 5pm on the Saturday before each election.
