In order to vote in the Primary and/or Genral Election of 2023 you must be

- A citizen of the United States
- A resident of Virginia
- At least 18 years of age or will be by the next general election

# **VOTER REGISTRATION**

Where You may apply online or at the following sites: County Registrar Office, Public Library; Department of Motor Vehicles Offices; Public Assistance Agency offices, i.e., those offering food stamps, aid to dependent children and/or aid to persons with disabilities, etc.: Military Recruitment Offices or District Governmental Centers. For other locations and for more information contact your General Registrar.

You may register year round except during the 21 days prior to a general or primary election or 13 days prior to a special general election. Registration will be permanent under most circumstances. Same day registration /voting is available within the 21days prior to and on election day with ballots considered as provisional until registration is approved.

To remain a qualified voter, you must notify your local voter registration office of any change in your name or address. For information, contact your General Registrar. Move

# **ABSENTEE VOTING**

Any registered voter who expects to be away or otherwise physically unable to go to the polls on Election Day, may request an absentee ballot.

By Mail or Fax: Application forms may be requested from the General Registrar's Office beginning ten months before the general election and are also available at registration sites and governmental centers. Mailed applications must be received by the General Registrar not less than seven days before an election. Voted ballots must be received in the office by 7 p.m. Election Day to be counted.

In Person: Registered voters may apply for and vote an absentee ballot in person at the Registrar's Office beginning 45 days before an election. In-person absentee votes must be cast by 5 p.m. on the Saturday before each Election Day.
